The MOH has reviewed the visiting in care homes guidance and some minor wording changes have been made in alignment with wider changes in the community. Of note is an added section reminding care homes of the importance of taking extra caution when visitors are children:

Children visiting care homes

Extra care should be taken where visitors are children, due to lack of vaccination coverage among this group and the fact that they do not take part in community testing.

When children visit care homes they should:

- only visit a residents' private room rather than spending time in any communal areas
- wear masks
- perform stringent hand and respiratory hygiene throughout the visit
